New Preorder Transaction

Ethernet Inquiry: Users select the radio button for either EVCID or RUID population, then enter the value and click **Submit**.

The response will then be displayed with the information for either EVC or RUID inquiry. Below are the **EVC Response** optional values:

- RUID - Related UNI Identifier
- NC – Network Channel
- NCI – Network Channel Interfaces
- VLAN – Virtual Local Area Network
- SPEC – Service and Project Enhancement Code
- LOS – Level of Service □ BDW - Bandwidth


