

This notice is being sent to notify Consolidated Communications Carrier Wholesale Care Customers that effective September 18, 2023; Consolidated Communications will implement the changes per the Industry's "Final" ASOG (Access Service Ordering Guidelines) Version 67 documentation within the Provisioning and Interface systems.

VFO and UOM Changes; Consolidated Communications will support the version 67 upgrades with the following exception:

The new EVCQTY field on the EVC form for combo ordering is only available in the West. It is not available in the East (ME, NH or VT):
